



General Information

Biblical Foundation-

- God's Word is foundational in all things
- NCS staff and families have a born-again testimony of their faith in Jesus Christ and a desire to serve and grow as Evangelical believers
- We conduct weekly chapel led by the dads.
- Primarily Christian curriculum
- A Statement of Faith is in our NCS Biblical Foundations

Service Oriented-

- All students are placed on teams where they help on campus on school days. Job assignments are rotated monthly.
- Parents not only have the responsibility of faithfully facilitating home-school days (Monday and Thursday) but are also involved in:
 - Teaching Chapel & PE (commitment by dads is once or twice a year Friday afternoons)
 - Helping in the classroom (moms or dads help about 6x a year)
 - Carry out regular service jobs that are assigned at the beginning of the year. We try place you according to your availability and giftedness. (Room Mom, Yearbook, Office Help, Friday Chapel & Elective Assistant, Friday Nursery, and Friday P.E. are some examples).
 - As a couple, you will be assigned to a committee. (Community Life, Spiritual Life, Fundraising, etc.)

Parental Responsibility-

At Home-

- Teach God's Word
- Character Training- (Obedience, respect for authority, respect for the property of others, self-control etc.)

For School-

- Set aside your home-school day- it's usually a full day of homework; unless it's an emergency, please don't use that day for other activities until the work is done.
- Keep in touch with the teacher
- Carry out Service Job and Committee responsibilities
- Promptly pay tuition and other fees.
- Help our fundraising committee raise funds for our school (2 events per year)

We Strive for Academic Excellence-

- Teachers at the Community School care for your child's academic and spiritual needs along with the desire that they glorify God in their actions.
- Teachers instruct all new concepts and are available on home-school days to answer questions either by phone or e-mail.
- Curriculum includes Abeka, Bob Jones, IEW and Saxon along with others.
- Students also thrive academically because of small class size and the one-on-one attention at home. 15:1 ratio. Otherwise, we provide the teacher an aide.
- PE, Elective, & Chapel are taught every Friday afternoon.
- Children will be required to complete 60 minutes of physical education at home. If your child is in sports, then this will fulfill their requirement.

Activities- In all the rewarding work there is fun too!

- Annual Thanksgiving Feast, Speech Meet (all our students participate) Spelling Bee, Open House and other yearly activities
- Class field trips are a fun time for our students and usually coincide with what they are learning in class.

Tuition and Fees-

- Application Fee- \$250 per family
- Curriculum Fee- Varies by grade. On average, \$200-\$275 per student. This fee is due in August.
- Student Program Fees- Varies by year. On average, it's \$250-300 per student (see "Additional Fees" sheet). This fee is added to the tuition cost.
- Tuition is currently \$4,500 per student for K-5th, \$5,675 per student for 6th - 8th and \$1850 per TK student (\$1,440 without afternoon extension). This fee is subject to change each year. It can be paid in full by August 1st. It may also be paid in 10 or 11 monthly installments due the 1st of each month.
- Late Fee- a late fee of \$25.00 will be assessed if your tuition is received after the 10th of the month.
